Built as a memorial to Margaret Tennant, our lovely chapel is open to residents 24 hours a day for private devotion. People of all denominations are welcome to join a weekly Communion service held each Tuesday at 10 AM and stated hours on Holy Days. A Catholic Mass is held on the first Wednesday of the month, also at 10 AM. The chapel belongs to all residents and can be used for services other than those scheduled as coordinated by the Chaplain.

Liturgical Ministry Opportunities

The worship life of the chapel offers opportunities for lay readers, Eucharistic ministers, acolytes, flower arrangement and altar work. The chaplain is happy to provide training if desired or needed to anyone who is interested in volunteering for a liturgical ministry.

Spiritual Care

The chaplain is available to provide spiritual care and pastoral counseling to all residents and their families regardless of religious orientation. The Rev. Kevin Philips, an Episcopal priest, has served Canterbury Woods since 1991 and has an MA in counseling. Fr. Kevin is here on campus on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday of each week and remains on call for pastoral emergencies and hospital visits.
