ON HER MAJESTY'S FRIGHTFULLY SECRET SERVICE by Rhys Bowen (M)

Royal Spyness #11. When royal sleuth Georgie Rannoch receives a letter from her friend Belinda (in an Italian villa awaiting the birth of her illegitimate baby), she yearns to run to her side. Then opportunity presents itself—her cousin the queen asks her to attend a house party in Italy to thwart a possible secret wedding between the Prince of Wales and the dreadful Mrs. Simpson.

A HIGHER LOYALTY by James Comey (N) Former FBI director James Comey shares his experiences from some of the highest-stakes situations of his career in the past two decades of American government, exploring what good, ethical leadership looks like, and how it drives sound decisions. His journey provides an unprecedented entry into the corridors of power, and his insights into what makes an effective leader.

TWO KINDS OF TRUTH by Michael Connelly (M)

Harry Bosch #22. Harry Bosch is back as a volunteer working cold cases for the San Fernando Police Department and is called out to a local drug store where a young pharmacist has been murdered. Meanwhile, an old case from Bosch's LAPD days comes back to haunt him when a long-imprisoned killer claims Harry framed him. The two unrelated cases wind around each other.

DEATH AT LA FENICE by Donna Leon (M)

Commissario Brunetti #1. There is little violent crime in Venice, a serenely beautiful floating city of mystery and magic, history and decay—until Maestro Helmut Wellauer, world-renowned conductor, dies painfully of cyanide during an intermission at La Fenice.

ENDGAME by Bill Pronzini (F)

Nameless Detective #40. Two twisty puzzles : One involves a woman whose husband died accidentally in a remote cabin in the Sierras. The other case is a missing person—who was agoraphobic and never left the house.

Alvirah & Willy #11. A glamorous cruise on a luxurious ocean liner turns deadly: Fleeing a disastrous and humiliating arrest of her husband-to-be on the eve of their wedding, Celia Kilbride, a gems and jewelry expert, hopes to escape from public attention by lecturing on a brand-new cruise ship...where famous Lady Emily Haywood is found dead and her priceless emerald necklace missing.

THE SITTING DUCKS by M. R. D. Meek (M)

Lennox Kemp #1. No one sees any links among a series of deaths in a small Cornish town...until Lennox Kemp with his city-bred suspicions comes to work in a local solicitor's office.

A TALE FOR THE TIME BEING by Ruth Ozeki (F)

In Tokyo, 16-year-old Nao plans to document in her diary the life of her Buddhist nun great-grandmother before she ends it all. Across the Pacific on a remote island, novelist Ruth discover a collection of artifacts washed ashore in a Hello Kitty lunchbox. As the mystery of its contents unfolds, Ruth is pulled into the past, into Nao's drama and unknown fate, and her own future.
