Recyclables

Some paper, plastic, metal, & glass items
No need to separate, place in paper bag or place on shelves

Trash

Food scraps, some used paper & plastic items, dog waste, cat litter

The following items require special handling

Never put them in the regular trash or recycle bins in the closet or other places. Canterbury Woods takes them to different organizations for recycling/disposal

Batteries of all types
– take to coat closet next to dining room

Used florescent bulbs –
take to coat closet next to dining room

Medicines – take to
Clinic office

Used computer ink cartridges – take to
basket in coat closet next to dinning room
